

Sustainable Timber Sourcing Policy

Lundy Projects Limited is fully committed to the principles of sustainable development throughout all its business operations. This policy statement sets out the strategic objective to responsibly source, procure and use timber products only from FSC/PEFC certified suppliers.

We recognise that global efforts are making steps to improve forest governance and eliminate illegal timber supply activities. Therefore, it is vitally important that as a socially responsible organisation we apply Local, UK and International Laws and Requirements.

In addition, Lundy Projects Limited will:

- Never knowingly become involved in the procurement of illegal timber supply activities.
- Work with our supply chain to ensure that where possible all timber products originate from FSC/PEFC certified sources.
- Ensure that on delivery requisitions the suppliers provide the License and Certificate Codes for all wood-derived products.
- Recognise that FSC/PEFC currently represents the standard and benchmark for responsible forest management, only Timber that meets this legal and sustainable sourcing criteria will be accepted on site.
- Make Periodic assurance checks to certify timber products meet the FSC/PEFC standard (See Images below).



Timber Reporting Requirements

Timber reporting is an essential aspect of meeting the assurance activities undertaken in all parts of the business, all projects / contracts are required to report on their timber usages on a periodic basis, Lundy Projects Limited will endeavour to meet all client requirements in this respect and provide an auditable trail of evidence to verify procurement and usage.

Communication of the Policy

It is the Managing Director's responsibility for the overall delivery of this policy to the business. Business Unit and Project Managers are accountable for ensuring the communication of this policy to their teams and suppliers engaged. It is the responsibility of the project teams to collate all data pertaining to the assurance and verification process of this policy. This policy has immediate effect and replaces all previous versions. This policy will be reviewed annually and amended where necessary.
